Playground Revitalization


As you may already be aware, work is being done towards a much-needed revitalization of St. Pius X's playground.

The south yard needs a facelift. The north yard is not much more than pavement. And, if we are successful in achieving our goals, even the JK/SK yard can be improved.

Last year, the parent council, along with some very helpful parents, began the necessary process with the TCDSB and, now that we have a proposed plan (visual plan of the yards), we are ready to go to the next step. In addition to obtaining and approving builder's plans, *this next step means coming up with the funds to pay.*

The school board no longer has funds for playgrounds; therefore, it is totally up to us. This will be a significant effort and there is no time to waste with a target start date for the work of Summer 2020.




Christmas Spirit Day - Nov. 29
